- Excessive use of a whip on any horse in a stall, runway, schooling area, show ring, or elsewhere on the competition/clinic grounds, before or during a competition, by any person. Any striking of the horse's head (on the poll and forward of the poll) with the whip shall be deemed excessive.
- Inhumane treatment of a horse in a stall, runway, school area, show ring, or elsewhere on the event grounds by any person.

Any action(s) against a horse by a competitor or an exhibitor which are deemed excessive by Horse Show/Clinic Management, in the ring or anywhere on the competition grounds may be punished by warning or elimination, as deemed appropriate by the Management.
